



The Bloomington Police Department has implemented a new bicycle registration program. The purpose of the bicycle registration is to assist the police department in returning lost or stolen bicycles to their rightful owners.

The registration program will not prevent bicycle thefts. Bicycle owners should still be careful about where they leave their bicycles when they are not riding them.

The program is completely free and voluntary on the part of the citizens. The information will only be kept at the Bloomington Police Department.

The form on back is for you to fill out if you choose to participate. The form may also be duplicated by you if you wish to register multiple bicycles.

You may bring your completed form to:

Monday through Friday from 8:00 am until 8:00 pm

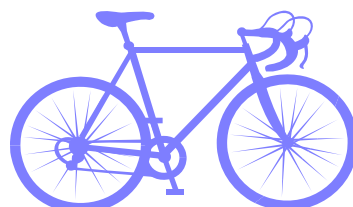
Stickers with a number that corresponds with the registration form will be issued.
