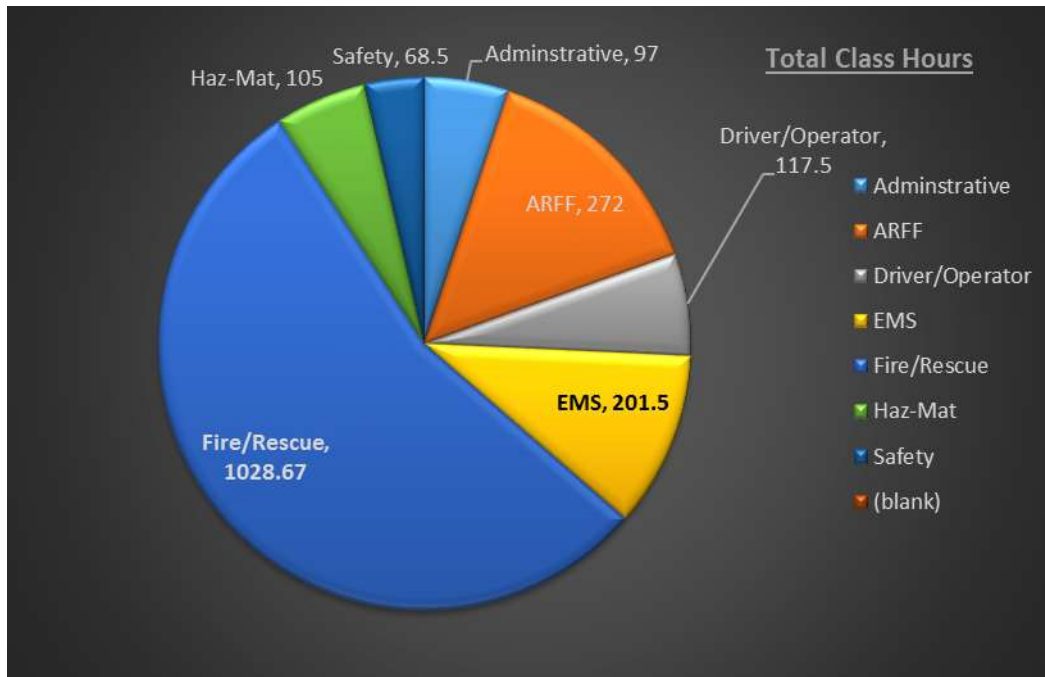


Fire Department Training Report for October, 2016

For the month of October 2016 the 5 Stations of the fire department held 321 training classes which totaled 1890.17 class hours. The class topics have been grouped into seven categories. They are Administrative, ARFF, Driver/Operator, EMS, Fire/Rescue, Hazmat, and Safety. The chart below represents the proportion of classes held in these seven categories for the month of October.
