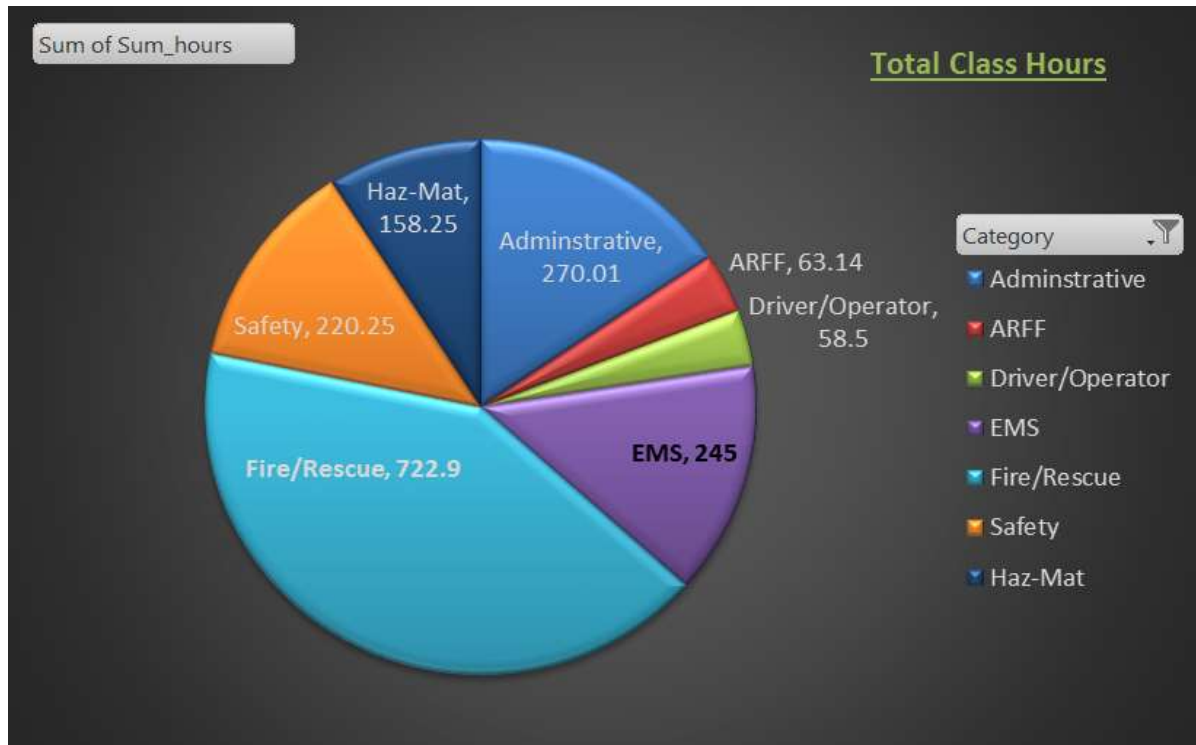


Fire Department Training Report for December, 2016

For the month of December 2016 the fire department held 61 training classes which totaled 1738.05 class hours. The class topics have been grouped into seven categories. They are Administrative, ARFF, Driver/Operator, EMS, Fire/Rescue, Safety, and Hazmat. The chart below represents the proportion of classes held in these seven categories for the month of December.
