

1. Call to order

The special meeting of the Liquor Commission was called to order by Commissioner Renner at 9:00 a.m. on December 28, 2016.

2. Roll Call

Tari Renner, Commissioner, George Boyle, Asst. Corporation Counsel, and Renee Gooderham, Chief Deputy Clerk.

3. Public Comment

Commissioner Renner opened the meeting to receive Public Comment. No individuals provided comments during the meeting.

4. Consideration of the application of Wingmen V, LLC, d/b/a Buffalo Wild Wings, located at 3220 E. Empire, requesting a RAS liquor license which would allow the sale of all types of alcohol by the glass for consumption on the premises seven (7) days a week.

Commissioner Renner introduced the liquor application. He explained that Wingmen V, LLC, d/b/a Buffalo Wild Wings was operating under a temporary liquor license extension on the basis of a management agreement with Threeputt, Inc. To continue operation beyond December 31, 2016, Wingmen would require a liquor license. Staff had arranged a Special City Council meeting following the Public Hearing to accommodate for the issuance of the 2017 liquor license.

Harlan C. Powell, owner/applicant attorney, Webster Powell and Casie Vogelsang, District Manager, Buffalo Wild Wings were present for the hearing.

Commissioner Renner questioned operational changes. Mr. Vogelsang responded negatively.

George Boyle, Corporation Counsel, stated that the business had not received any violations.

Commissioner Renner summarized the recommendation to the December 28, 2016 Special City Council Meeting: that the application of Wingmen V, LLC, d/b/a Buffalo Wild Wings, located at 3220 E. Empire, requesting a RAS liquor license which would allow the sale of all types of alcohol by the glass for consumption on the premises seven (7) days a week be approved contingent upon with all health and safety codes.
