1. Call to order

The meeting of the Liquor Commission was called to order by Commissioner Renner at 4:00 p.m. on January 10, 2017.

2. Public Comment

Commissioner Renner opened the meeting to receive Public Comment. No individuals provided comments during the meeting.

3. Consideration of approving the Commission Minutes of December 13, 2016 and December 28, 2016.

Commissioner Renner approved the minutes as he did not have any edits to the minutes presented.

4. Consideration of the request from Robert King and Sara Finney to allow moderate consumption of alcohol at their March 18, 2017 wedding reception to be held at Miller Park Pavilion.

When asked whether the cater had received their license or applied for the caterer permit by the City, Mr. King stated Party in a Pinch (Farmer City) was awaiting receipt of its license by the State.

Commissioner Renner stated he would recommend the item be sent to Council for its review and consideration on the February 13, 2017 Regular Council Meeting agenda, but that it would be contingent on Party in a Pinch applying for and receiving the City's catering liquor license.
