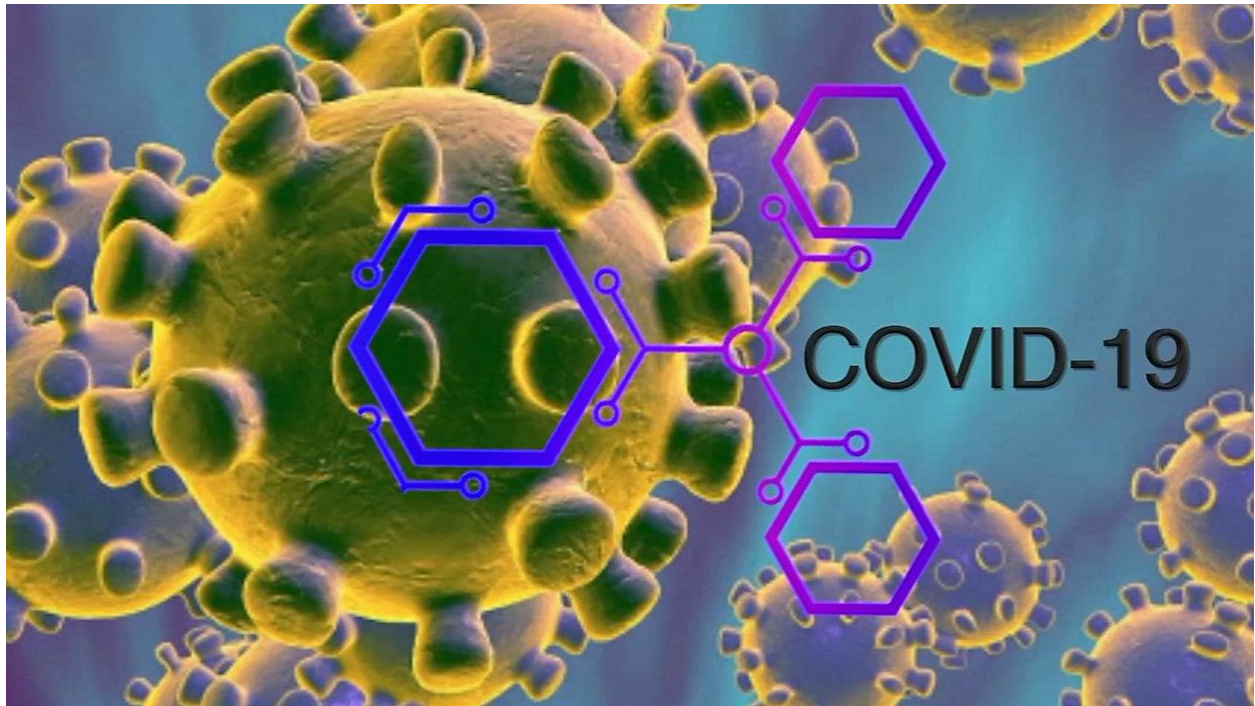

§ 8.1 INTRODUCTION

Under the City Code, video gaming license renewals are due every year on April 1. As a result of the COVID-19 virus, many video gaming establishments are closed. City Manager Executive Order 2020-3 was issued on April 2, 2020, to extend the date for renewal applications to April 24, 2020. Consistent with a payment delay offered by the Illinois Gaming Board, this City Manager Executive Order is to allow payment of the City's video gaming license fee due at the time the license is issued or 10 days after the Illinois Gaming Board resumes statewide video gaming operations.

§ 8.2 AUTHORITY

On March 26, 2020, the City Council approved an Ordinance Declaring Local Emergency due to the COVID-19 Virus & Enacting Various Emergency Measures. Section 2(C) of that Ordinance authorizes the City Manager to address licensing issues, upon concurrence with the Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem.

§ 8.3 FILING DEADLINE

For the license year beginning May 1, 2020 and ending April 30, 2021, the deadline for filing renewal applications for Video Gaming Licenses issued by the City is April 24, 2020. No fines or penalties shall be assessed on any video gaming license renewal application that is completed and filed by April 24, 2020.

§ 8.4 EXTENSION OF VIDEO GAMING LICENSE FEE DUE DATE

All video gaming terminal fees associated with renewal applications, due no later than April 24, 2020, must be paid at the time of application or no later than 10 business days after the Illinois Gaming Board resumes statewide video gaming operations.
