Beautification & Walkability

- Parks and Recreation Department completed landscaping . . improvements at the Law & Justice Center and along Front St.
- Public Works Department completed Front St. streetscape including installation of electrical conduit
- Sidewalk & ADA ramp improvements
- Resurfacing of Main Street (from Front to Mulberry) & Monroe Street (from Madison to East)
- High visibility crosswalk and signage installed on Center St. at Monroe St.
- Expanded Holiday Decorations throughout 15 blocks
- Purchase & installation of 94 self-watering planters
- Installation of new spring/summer banners
- Continuing to provide power-washing of sidewalks
- Expanded partnership with Marcfirst for litter and leaf cleanup



Programming in Public Places


- 56 Events held in 2019 & 57 Events scheduled in 2020
- Expanded programming at the Farmers' Market
 - Average outdoor market attendance 3,000 patrons
 - Developed Curbside Farmers' Market to facilitate an online store with curbside pickup during COVID-19
 - Partnered with Public Works to install electrical outlets at the base of the decorative street lighting around the square allowing for better accessibility
- Applied for Bloomberg Asphalt Grant to fund Route 66 Parklet
- Coordinated with businesses to utilize parklets during special events






Outreach & Advertising
