

PSCRB – June 18, 2020 at 5 pm

1. Call to Order
 - a. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Taylor at 5:01pm.
2. Roll Call
 - a. Members Woodard and Bennett were absent. Member Bennett eventually joined at 5:05 pm.
3. Public Comment
 - a. None.
4. Board Member Comment
 - a. Each Board Member was given the opportunity to make remarks regarding recent events involving the death of George Floyd. Generally, the Board agreed these were difficult times but expressed appreciation of BPD and the community as a whole, though there is still work to be done.
5. Consideration of Approving Meeting Minutes
 - a. This item was tabled as minutes were not ready yet.
6. Discussion of Complaints Received
 - a. BPD reported five complaints this year so far, 3 of them open. There has been some delay in review due to COVID.
7. General Updates from Bloomington Police Department
 - a. AC Wamsley gave a report, stating that hired six new people, including some minority individuals. Hiring is a priority for the department. COVID has delayed the department's wellness program.
8. Annual Report Review and Approval
 - a. Chairman Taylor reviewed the annual report. Member Lancaster motioned to approve it, seconded by Member Bosquez. Motion passed unanimously. They will get on the schedule to present at an upcoming Council meeting.
9. Discussion of Vacancy on Board
 - a. Member Lancaster recommended Cinnamon Porter. Member Bosquez recommended Adela Espindola. Chairman Taylor asked the Board to bring others forward, too, and encourage them to apply.
10. Nomination and Election of Board Chair and Vice Chair
 - a. Discussion was had, and ultimately Member Lancaster nominated Member Bosquez as Chair and Member Bennett as Vice Chair. This was seconded by Member Fish and unanimously approved.
11. Discussion of Future Meeting Dates, Times, Location, and Topics (including agenda for the next Quarterly Meeting)
 - a. The next Regular and Quarterly meetings are scheduled for July 8 at 5 and 6 pm, respectively. How the meeting takes place will depend on COVID restrictions at the time. Chair Bosquez would like to consult with others on agenda items.
