## John M. Scott to Host Community Meeting on FY22 Grant Program

BLOOMINGTON, IL— The FY22 John M. Scott Health Care Commission's FY22 Request for Proposals for Category II Community Health Priority grants is now available. The Commission will accept online applications from November 15<sup>th</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>. \$485,000 is available to support organizations and initiatives that prevent illness and promote the health and well-being of income-qualified McLean County residents. Both programmatic and capital proposals will be accepted. Applications will only be accepted through online software linked through www.cityblm.org/jmsgrants.

An information session will be held on Wednesday, November 18<sup>th</sup> from 2:00 – 3:00 pm via Zoom. Although the meeting is not required, the Commission strongly recommends interested applicants participate. The meeting will offer insight into the overall mission of the Trust and goals of the grants program and how they tie to the grant-making process.
