

# JULY 2021 SPECIAL BULK PICKUP

JULY 6 - 19, 2021



Public Works crews will be collecting bulk waste from July 6-19 for the July 2021 Special Bulk Pickup. This is part of the City's effort to help clean up after a series of flooding events during the last weekend in June 2021. The service is offered at no additional charge for Solid Waste Program users. All bulk waste must be placed in separate piles behind the curb by 6:00 a.m. on the scheduled date.

- Furniture
- Items of waste generated by cleaning out a house (other than food waste)
- Basement, interior, and exterior remodeling debris (permit may be required)

## NO

- Commercial waste
- Liquids (i.e. paint, varnish, stain, paint materials, oils, or chemicals)
- Electronics
- Food waste
- Extreme demolitions

During this special pickup, brush pickup will be suspended. The map and projected collection start dates are shown below. Users may take bulk waste and brush to the Citizen Convenience Center, which is located at 402 S. East Street in Bloomington (south of the Bloomington Public Library) and is open from 7 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays and from 11 a.m. to 6:45 p.m. on Wednesdays. The facility is closed on Sundays, Mondays, and municipal holidays.
