I am writing to express my support for the City of Bloomington's application to the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) grant program offered by the U.S. Department of Transportation. Funding from this program will enable Bloomington to fund improvements to the Hamilton Road East-West Gap project.

Located in Central Illinois, Bloomington sits at the crossroads of three major interstate corridors, connecting with Indianapolis and the Quad Cities on Interstate 74, Chicago to St. Louis on Interstate 55, and Interstate 39 to Madison Wisconsin. The City is home to a diverse group of businesses and residents including State Farm Insurance, ranked 36th on the Fortune 500, Country Financial and Illinois Wesleyan University. Finally, the project will boost economic development opportunities in the project area, enhancing access to existing employers and sparking new development along the completed Hamilton Road corridor.

As a senator and member of the Committee of Commerce, Science and Transportation, I have made modernizing Illinois' transportation infrastructure one of my top priorities. Bloomington's proposal aligns with both my priorities and the core goals of the RAISE program by improving transit safety, fostering regional economic competitiveness and enhancing the quality of life for Illinois residents.
