Man Arrested for Residential Burglary after Officers find Stolen Vehicle at Suspects Residence

Bloomington, IL - On Sunday, 9/26/2021, at approximately 4:15 a.m., Bloomington Police officers were dispatched to the 700 block of W. Mulberry St. for a theft complaint. Upon arrival, officers learned a vehicle and other personal property were stolen during a residential burglary. A few minutes later, officers located the stolen vehicle approximately 1/2 of a block away, parked in the rear of the suspect's residence, in the 500 block of N. Mason St. During the investigation, officers were able to identify the suspect as Ryan M. Mooney, 29, of Bloomington. During the arrest, officers had to restrain the suspect several times, which led to additional arrest charges.

Ryan M. Mooney was arrested and later charged by the McLean County State's Attorneys Office with:

- CNT 1 RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY
- CNT 2 BURGLARY W/O CAUSING DAMAGE
- CNT 3 RESIST/PC OFF/CORR EMP/FRFTR
- CNT 4 RESIST/PC OFF/CORR EMP/FRFTR
- **CNT 5 CRIMINAL TRESPASS TO VEHICLES**

Bond requested by the McLean County State's Attorney Office was \$100,000 -10% to apply.

All suspect(s) are presumed innocent unless proven guilty in the court of law.
