## Shooting Injures Pregnant Juvenile

**Bloomington, IL** - On Monday, 9/27/2021, at approximately 7:30 p.m., Bloomington Police officers were dispatched to the 1300 block of N. Hershey Rd for a "shots fired" call for service. Upon arrival, officers located evidence that gunfire had struck one of the occupied apartments and later learned that the gunfire struck a 17-year-old pregnant victim. The victim was transported to Carle BroMenn Emergency Room for medical treatment. The victim's injury was consistent with a gunshot wound but is not considered life threatening.

There were no additional injuries reported, no suspect(s) information to release, and no arrests have been made at this time. This incident is still under investigation.
