BPD to Prioritize Traffic Safety "Safe Driving, Saves Lives"

Bloomington, IL - Bloomington Police Chief Jamal Simington is announcing the Bloomington Police Department's (BPD) commitment to prioritizing traffic safety, in order to make our roadways and our community safer.

Chief Simington said, "Since 2020, Bloomington has had 3,269 crashes. Five of those were fatal traffic crashes and 478 involved a traffic crash with at least one person being injured. Traffic crashes are a killer in the community and it is imperative that the BPD play a strategic and important role in lowering traffic crashes. We are also asking the community to partner with us in this endeavor by committing to safe driving."

The BPD's prioritization will focus on the four E's of traffic safety: education, enforcement, engineering, and emergency services.

Education: Educate the community via social media and the BPD's website as well as continue partnerships with traffic safety advocacy groups.

Enforcement: Enforce traffic laws specifically targeting high traffic crash locations, driving under the Influence (D.U.I) violations, and community traffic complaint locations.

Engineering: BPD will continue to work with traffic engineering and the community to review roadway designs.

Emergency Services: BPD will continue to work with other first responders, in order to better respond to traffic crashes.

Chief Simington added, "We need everyone do to their part in keeping the community safe! Remember, safe driving, saves lives."
