Bloomington Man Arrested for Sex Offenses against a Juvenile

Bloomington, IL - On Wednesday, 3/30/2022, at approximately 3:00 p.m., Bloomington police officers arrested Wilmer A. Marquez-Ayala, 35, of Bloomington, Illinois for nine McLean County warrants,

without incident. Marquez-Ayala's warrants were issued on 3/30/2022 as a result of a sex offense investigation that began on November 11th, 2021 in Bloomington.

As a result of the investigation, BPD detectives learned that a juvenile victim, who Marquez-Ayala knew, was sexually assaulted for approximately a year. Out of respect for the victim, no additional information will be released.

After the arrest, Marquez-Ayala was transported to the McLean County Jail. The bond on the McLean County warrants was \$1,000,000 - 10% to apply.

Chief Jamal Simington said, "Sexual assault and abuse has no place in our society. We strive as a police agency to diligently investigate these serious crimes and seek justice for sexual assault victims. We also partner with community stakeholders to discuss preventive
