REVIEW OF SELECT CRIME TYPES

IMPACT OF FRAUD IN 2021



- During January, February and March of 2020, we took an average of 11 fraud reports each month.
- Near the end of March 2020, our reports began to increase, in direct correlation to fraudulent activity focused on state and federal COVID-19 financial relief.
- In January, February and March of 2021, we were taking an average of 40 fraud reports each month.
 - This increase in Fraud altered our 2021 NIBRS crime totals by +11.7 percent.
 - Without this spike in Fraud, our 2021 total NIBRS crime would have been down by -1.7%.




HOMICIDES IN 2021

• We recorded 4 homicides in 2021.




- Single shooting homicide 2412 Clearwater on 3-7-21. Arrest made.
- Single shooting homicide at 808 E. Washington on 11-4-21. Investigation open.
- Single stabbing homicide in the 600 block of W. Seminary. Arrest made.
- Year to date (2022) BPD has 5 homicides.





GUN VIOLENCE IN 2021

- BPD recorded 31 shootings in 2021, up from 27 in 2020.
- In 2021, 3 subjects were killed by gunfire.
- Most of the shootings involved one of three scenarios:
 - Personal conflicts where one or more parties were armed during confrontations
 - Gang on gang retaliation
 - Robberies of individuals for their gun(s) or drugs (primarily marijuana)











- Large caliber handguns continue to be the primary tool in crimes of violence.
- Higher capacity magazines are now common.
- In early 2022, BPD seized the first "switch", a part used to convert a Glock handgun to fully automatic.
- Guns come from a mixture of local burglaries, "straw purchases" and out-of-state purchases.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN 2021




- The following data represents reports taken for both physical and non-physical domestic incidents.
- Our increase of 5.5% over 2020 is consistent with nationwide studies on the impact of COVID-19 (+8.1% - National Commission on COVID-19 and Criminal Justice, 2020).

DUI ARRESTS IN 2021



- Our total for DUI arrests (252) in 2021 is just under the five-year average of 258 DUIs.
- DUI enforcement remains a high priority at BPD.



TRENDS IN 2021

- Locally, we are seeing a continued increase in the use and dealing of Methamphetamine.
- In 2021, officers from Bloomington/Normal deployed Narcan on 43 individuals suspected of overdosing on drugs. Approximately 65% of the drug overdose deaths in this area involved drugs containing Fentanyl.
- Organized retail thefts continue to amount to large losses from local retail chains. These thefts involve organized crews of 3 to 5 subjects taking specific products.
- BPD handles on average (over 4 years), 1,903 vehicle accidents.
 - In 2021 we handled 1,873 vehicle accidents
 - In 2022 we would like to reduce this total by 10%
