Shots Fired Incident

Bloomington, IL –On Saturday, 06/11/22, at approximately 5:22 pm., Bloomington Police officers were dispatched to the 1800 block of Lincoln Street, for a shots fired call for service. Officers on scene located physical evidence that a shooting had occurred. Through the investigation, probable cause was developed for the arrest of Tyler Neely.

On Monday, 06/13/22, after a foot pursuit, Tyler Neely was arrested.

Arrested was Tyler Neely, 23, of Selma Alabama for:

- -AGGRAVATED DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM (3 counts)
- -RECKLESS DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM
- -POSSESSION OF METH< 5 GRAMS

Neely was transported to the McLean County Jail. At the time of this release, Neely's bond is currently set at \$350,000.00 - 10 percent applies
