


WHAT IS HAZARD MITIGATION PLANNING?

- Identifies vulnerabilities
- Develops mitigation actions to lessen and sometimes eliminate the effects of hazards
- Makes the City eligible to apply for and receive federal hazard mitigation funds to implement mitigation actions identified in the plan
