Background

- The CAPER covers the City's 2021 Program Year (May 1, 2021-April 30, 2022)
- The CAPER provides a snapshot of the City's performance on achieving goals established in the current Consolidated Plan (2020-2024)

PY2021 Accomplishments

- Rehabilitation of 13 single-family, owner-occupied units
- Boiler replacement serving 21 Bloomington Housing Authority multi-family housing units
- Construction of accessibility ramps for 3 single-family housing units
- Demolition of 1 deteriorated structure
- 6 public service projects funded
- 2 public facility improvements
- West Corridor sidewalk replacement and repair

PY2021 Overall Spending

- Total Spent on PY2021 Activities (To Date)= \$461,135.89
- Total Expected to be spent on PY2021 Activities Remaining= \$117,487.32
- Total Projected Expenditures for PY2021 Activities= **\$578,623.21**

PY2021 Spending By Activity Category (To Date)

- Housing Rehabilitation Activities= \$245,196.03
- Demolition Activities= \$20,770.00
- Public Services= \$75,506.25
- Public Facility and Infrastructure Activities= \$41,912.68
(\$117,487.32 remaining per projections)
- Fair Housing, Community Planning, and Section 3 Training Activities= \$56,589.57
- Administration of CDBG Program= \$21,161.36
