

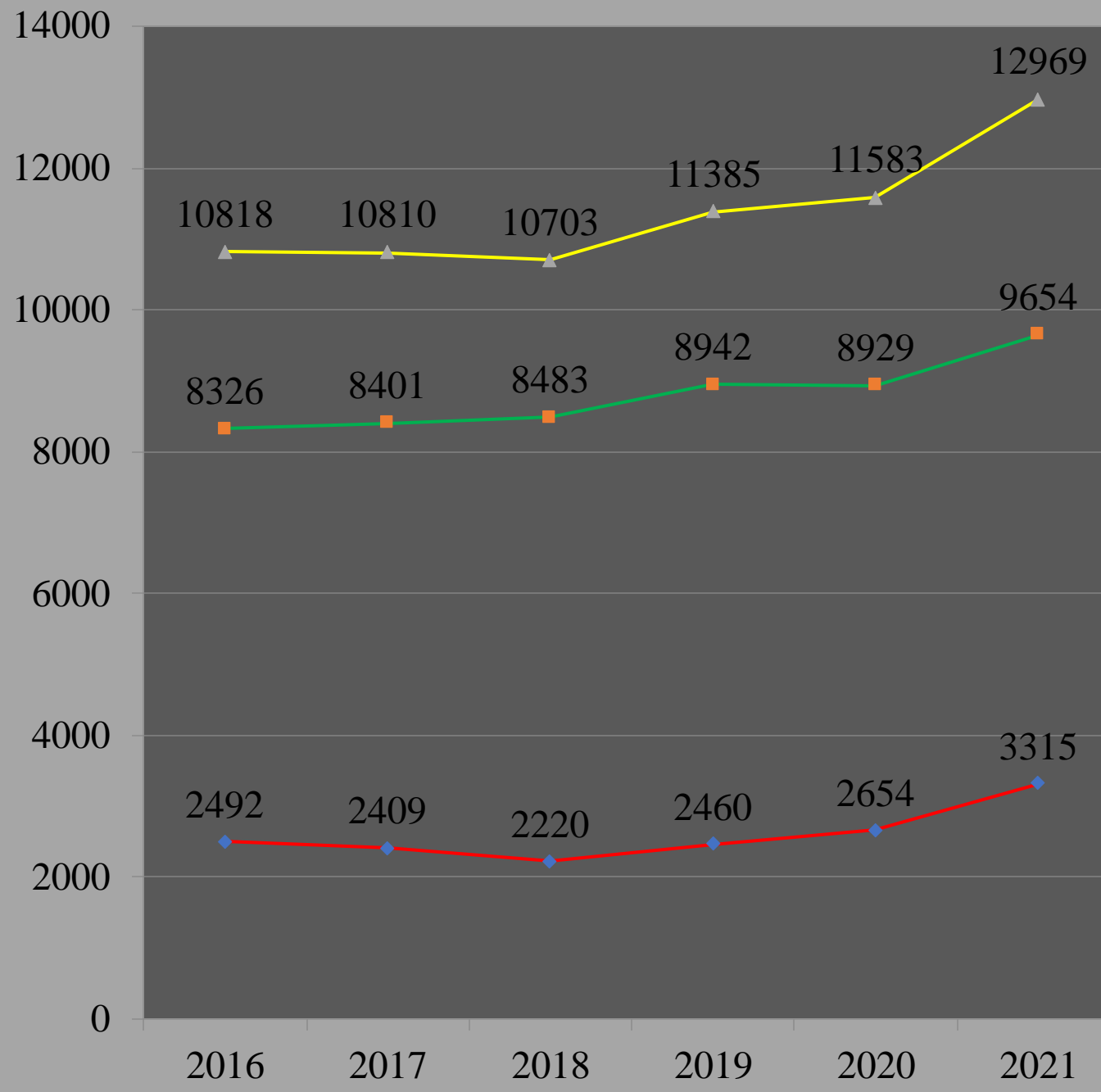

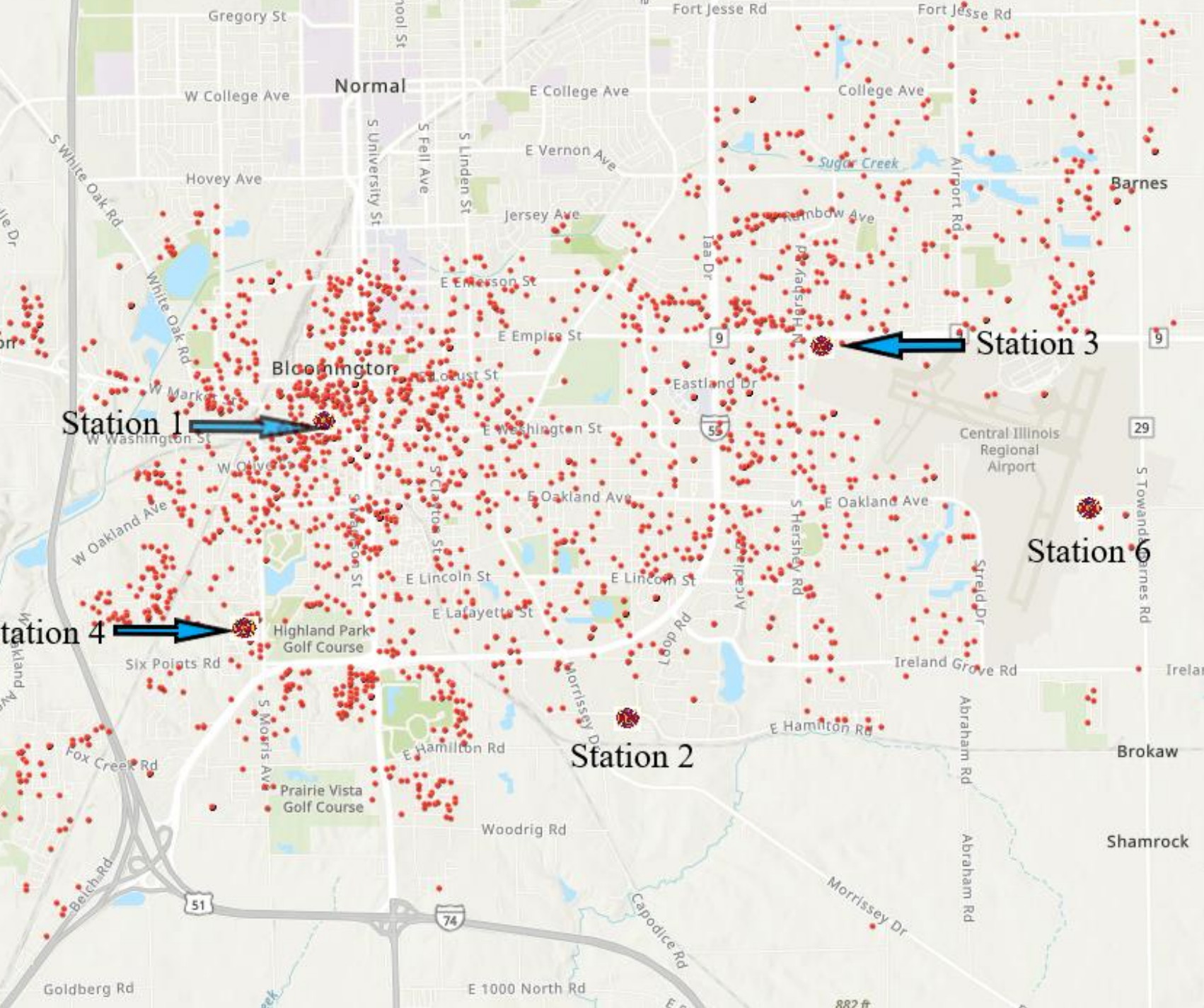


Number of Incidents over past 6 years.



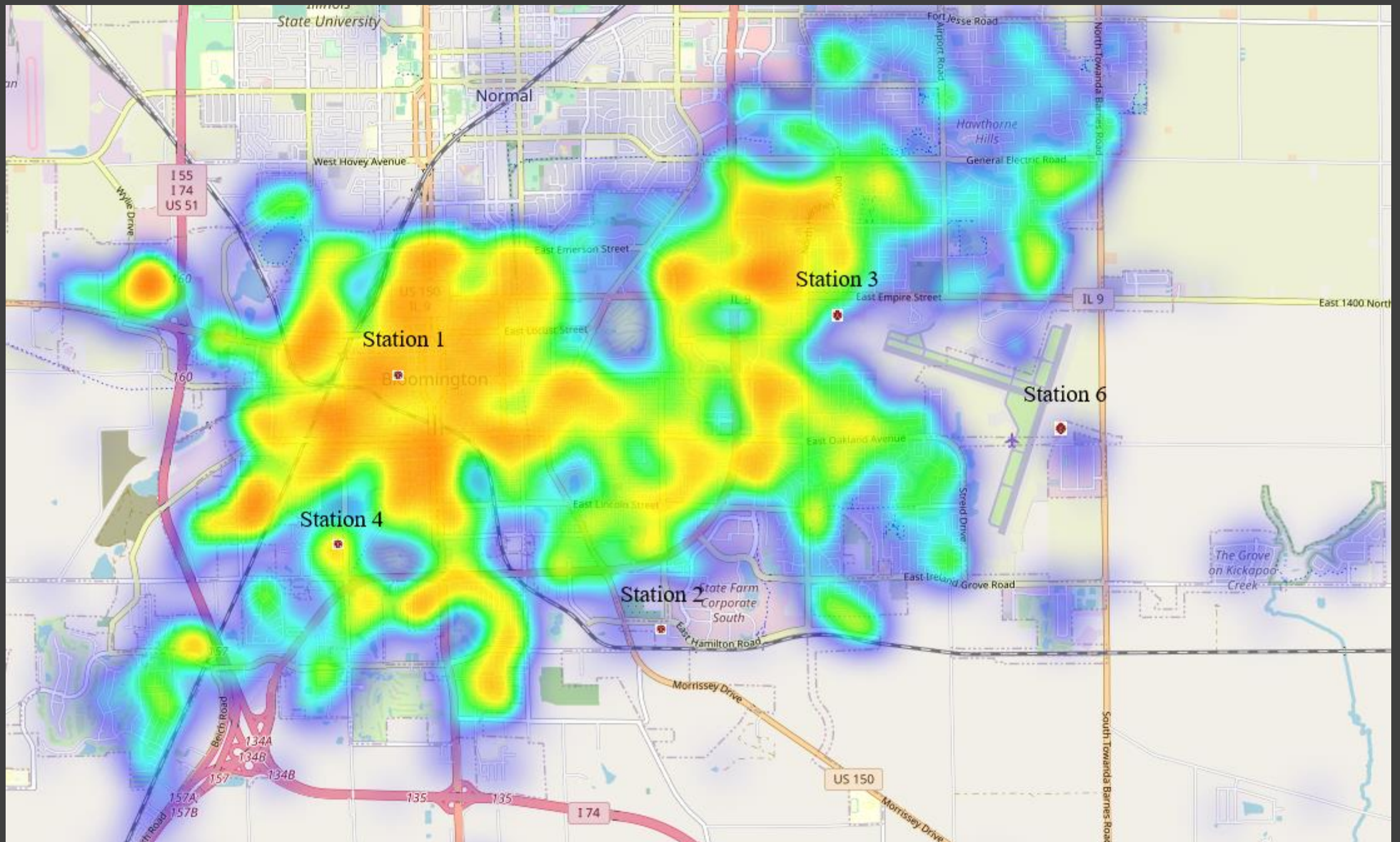

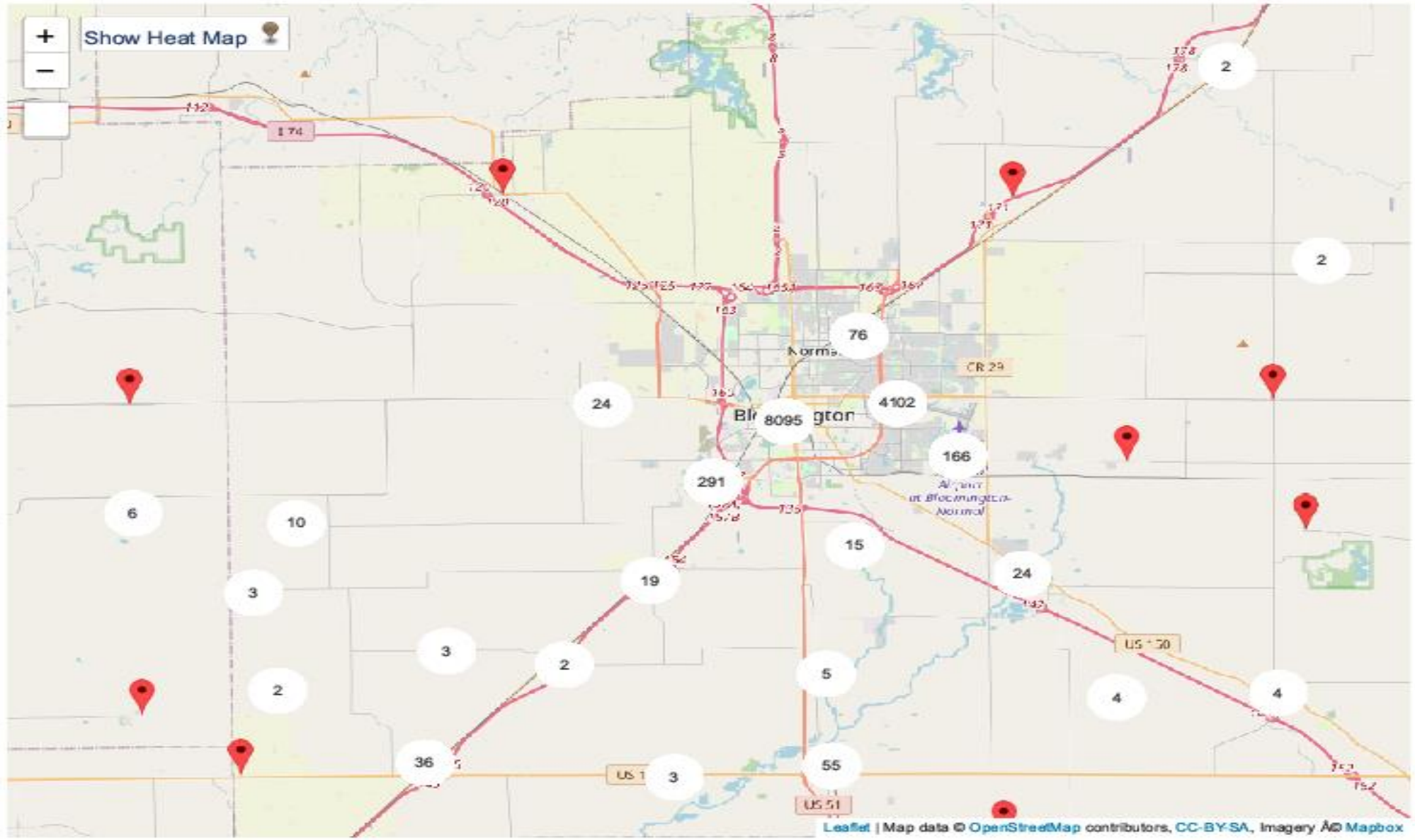




Incidents by Stations

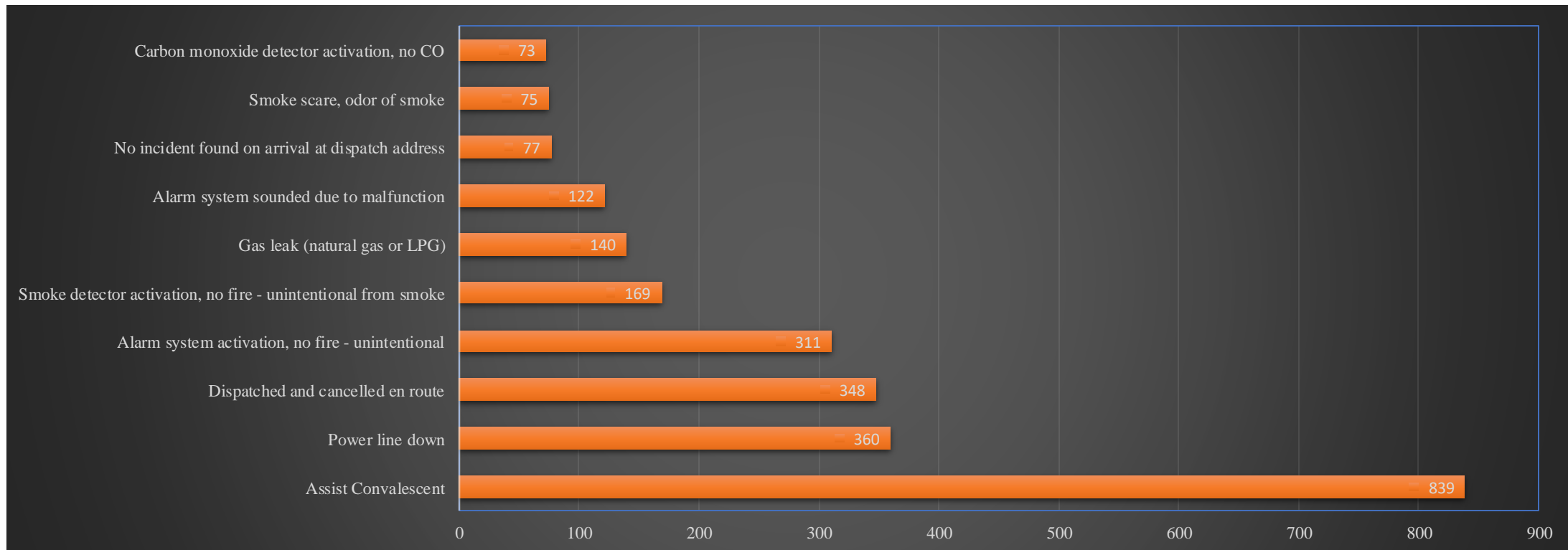
- Station 1 5648

Fires

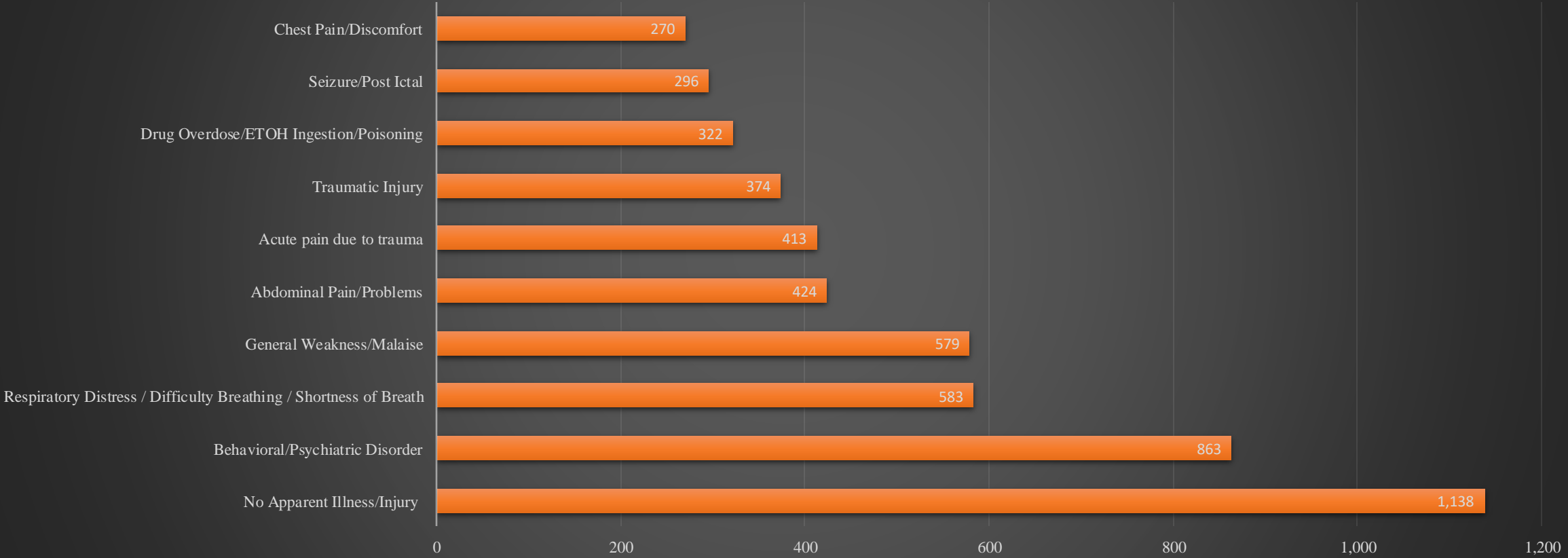
- 221 Total Fires

- 12 – Civilian Injuries



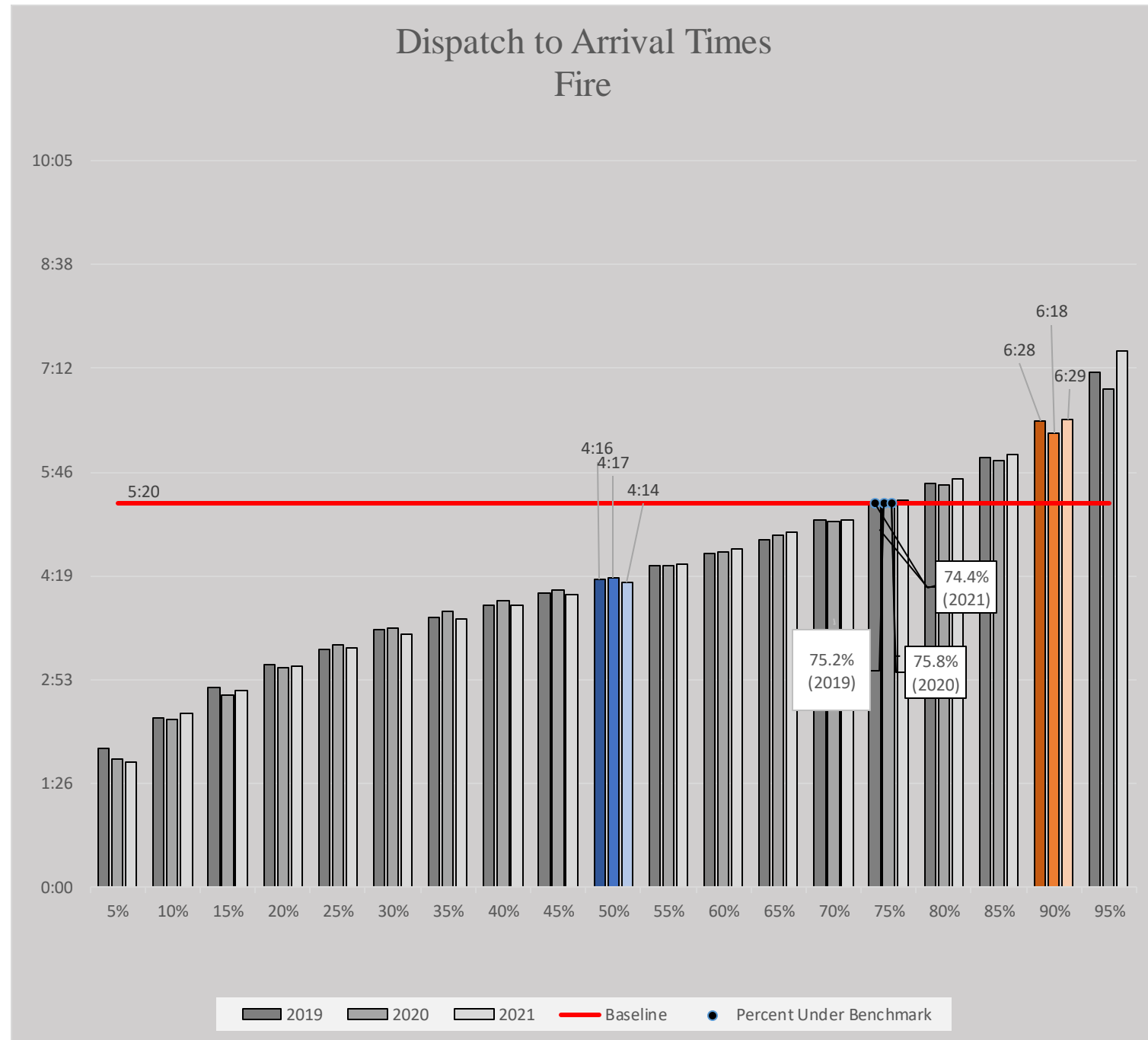

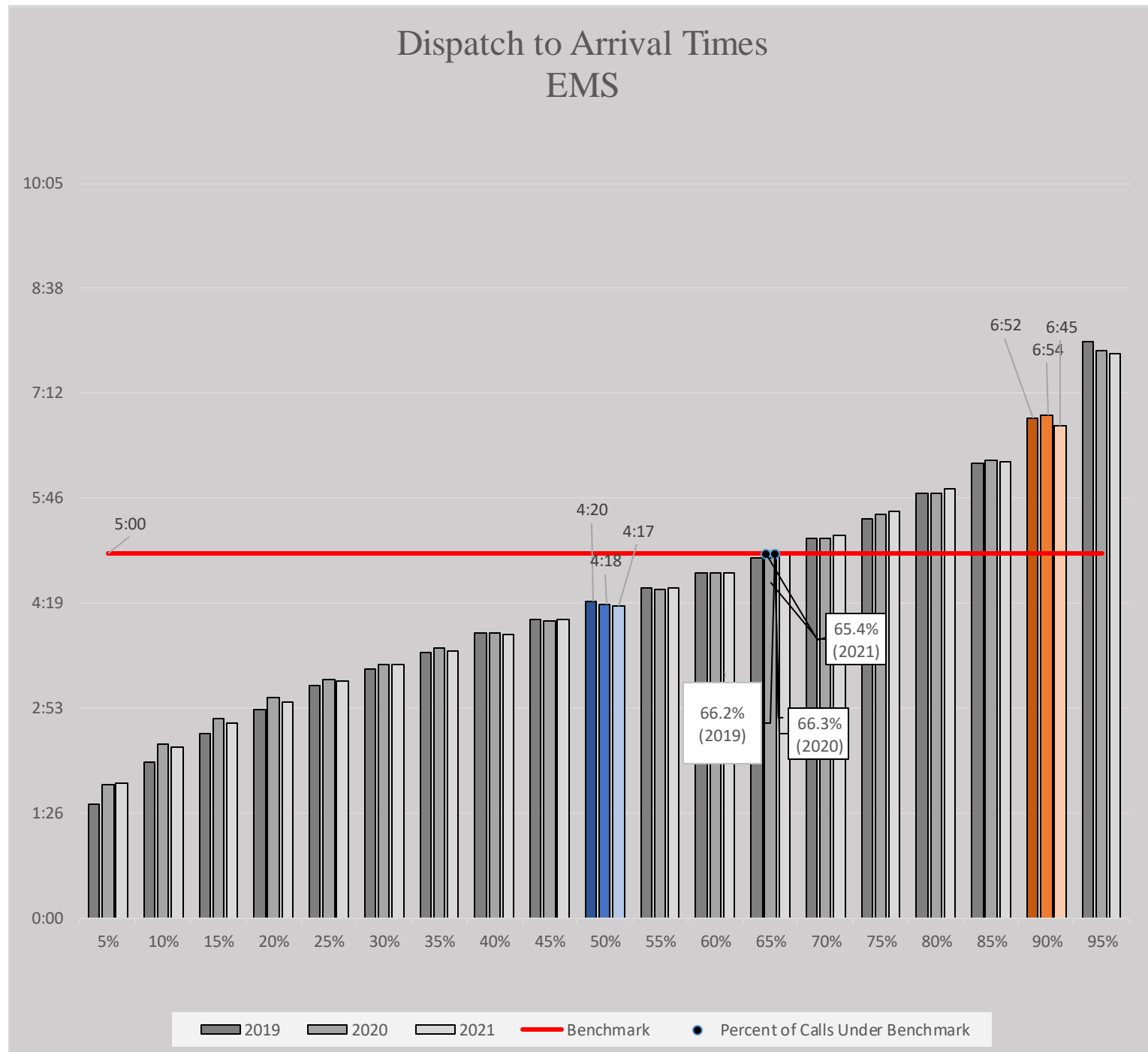
Top 10 EMS Primary Impressions
