PERSON SHOT

Bloomington, IL - On Friday, 9/2/2022, at approximately 07:34 p.m., Bloomington police officers heard a gunshot (s) being fired. Shortly thereafter, officers were dispatched to the area of Kenyon Court for an injured person. Upon arrival, officers learned an adult male had sustained a wound (s) from a gunshot (s). The victim was transported to a local hospital. The victim is currently in critical condition.

Currently, there is believed to be no danger to the public. We request you avoid the areas Woodruff Drive and Kenyon Court as the streets are currently closed.

The circumstances behind this incident are still pending investigation. At this time, no arrests have been made. Anyone with information should contact the Bloomington Police Department at 309-820-8888.
