MINUTES BLOOMINGTON TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TUESDAY, APRIL 20, 2021 4:00 P.M. COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL 109 EAST OLIVE STREET BLOOMINGTON, ILLINOIS

This meeting was conducted under Governor Pritzker's Executive Order 2020-07, Section 6 implemented in response to COVID-19, which suspended in-person attendance under the Open Meeting Act, 5 ILCS 120.

The Transportation Commission Regular meeting convened virtually via Zoom conferencing with City Traffic Engineer Philip Allyn (Staff Liaison); City Engineer Craig Shonkwiler; and Commission Chairperson Maureen Bradley in-person in City Hall's Council Chambers.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Ms. Rickielee Benecke, Ms. Maureen (Reenie) Bradley, Mr. Edward Breitweiser, Ms. Elicssha Sanders

MEMBERS ABSENT: None

OTHERS PRESENT: Mr. Kevin Kothe, Director of Public Works; Mr. Craig Shonkwiler, City Engineer; Mr. Philip Allyn, City Traffic Engineer.

1. CALL TO ORDER: Ms. Bradley called the meeting to order at 4:23 pm.

2. ROLL CALL: Mr. Allyn called the roll. With four members in attendance, a quorum was established.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT: None

4. MINUTES: Reviewed and approved the minutes of the September 15, 2020, regular meeting of the Bloomington Transportation Commission and the February 10, 2021, Special Joint meeting with Planning Commission. Mr. Allyn explained the changes of the Joint Meeting notes to correct to remove the names of David Stanczak, Sheila Montney, John Danenberger, and Ms. Headean from the roll call and correcting the title of Mr. Kevin Kothe to Director of Public Works. Mr. Allyn then explained the motion would be to approve the minutes with these corrections. Ms. Benecke made a motion to approve the September minutes and the February minutes as corrected. Mr. Breitweiser seconded the motion. The Transportation Commission unanimously approved the motion 4-0 via roll call vote.

5. REGULAR AGENDA:

A. TC-2021-01: Pedestrian Street Crossing Treatment Policy – Review and approval

Mr. Allyn explained that the city wanted to make a policy for Pedestrian Crossings for the city to use as it continues to work on various projects around the city. Mr. Allyn stated that this is a policy for the commission to review and approve as the transportation commission is a policy level board. He then went

on to explain how the policy was created from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) guidelines that were put out within the last few years and based off several research projects and various data studies. He reviewed how the city will use the table to investigate which treatments should be considered for each individual intersection. Mr. Allyn pointed out the biggest difference between the proposed City policy and FHWA guidelines is the splitting of the smallest FHWA AADT group into three separate ranges. This recognizes that a 500 vehicle per day street is not the same as a 3,000 vehicle per day or a 6,000 vehicle per day street and allows better guidance for these lower volume streets. Mr. Allyn also discussed how the different treatment options were determined for the additional volume ranges.

Ms. Bradley stated she was happy to see this policy in place as it uses objective, scientific data to determine the crossing treatments to be considered. She also appreciated the additional categories for the lower volumes since most of the City's streets are less than 9,000 vehicles per day.

Ms. Benecke asked if the policy addresses any ADA requirements or the Illinois Accessibility Code. Mr. Allyn explained the guidelines are focused on the traffic control recommendations. He explained the city would refer to the PROAG or ADA guidelines for the specific design details on the crossing. For example, this policy would point to using an RRFB with pedestrian warning signs. Staff would then apply ADA and PROWAG accessibility requirements for the design of the push button that activates the RRFB, the signs that go with the push buttons, the slopes for the sidewalk ramps at the buttons, the size of the warning signs, etc. Ms. Benecke appreciates the layout and the details provided in the proposed policy.

Mr. Breitweiser complemented the team for putting the policy together and Mr. Allyn for explaining the table. He then asked for examples of roads that would fall into the smaller categories of AADT below the 9,000 per day to help visualize the ranges. Mr. Allyn then access the "Getting around Illinois" website for AADT for Bloomington streets and provided examples of streets for each of the categories. Mr. Breitweiser asked if most streets over 15,000 AADT are state roads and if so, does IDOT follow the same policy. Mr. Allyn explained the FHWA guidelines are intended as guidance for agencies. While the City cannot dictate what the state does, and while we don't always know details of IDOT's internal policies, it can be assumed there is a similar policy that they follow.

Mr. Breitweiser made a motion to approve the policy. Ms. Benecke seconded the motion. The Transportation Commission unanimously approved the motion 4-0 via roll call vote.

B. Information: April 2021 Citizen Comments/Complaints Summary (Review & Discussion)

Ms. Bradley commented on the number of citizen complaints decreasing and asked if there were any specific questions/comments. Mr. Breitweiser asked about #106 "Request for Deaf Child warning sign" and how we handle those requests. Mr. Allyn explained that the city will go out and evaluate the situation and talk to the requestor. Mr. Allyn explained the City generally does not install signs warning of a situation that isn't always present or is applicable for a large area and not a specific location. For example, Children at Play warning signs are typically applicable to an entire residential area resulting in ambiguity for drivers that leads to ignoring the warning especially when combined with rarely actually seeing children playing. The city does evaluate each request on a case-by-case basis. No other questions or comments.

6. OLD BUSINESS:

A. Towanda Barnes and Baywood Pedestrian Crossing

Mr. Allyn provided an update about the pedestrian crossing at the Baywood and Towanda Barnes intersection. The City has been collecting data and talking with the County about possible updates to the area. The County will be installing Pedestrian Crossing signs and Speed Radar Feedback signs to help slow traffic down. The City will be redoing the sidewalk ramps at this intersection by removing the

southern crossing and installing ramps on the northern crossing. This will decrease the number of lanes that pedestrians will have to cross.

7. NEW BUSINESS: None

8. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS: Mr. Allyn reminded the commissioners to make sure they have filed their Statement of Economic Interest form. They should have received an email from the County with information on the form. The due date is May 1st.

9. ADJOURNMENT: Ms. Sanders made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Breitweiser seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously 4-0 via roll call vote, and the meeting was adjourned at 5:01 pm.

Staff has implemented the routine changes proposed, evaluated the results, and determined that it is appropriate for the modifications to become permanent.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Approval

Staff recommends the Transportation Commission pass the following motion:

A. Recommend That City Council Approve the proposed ordinance modifying Sections 29-703, 29-1611, 29-1801, 29-1807, 29-1811, and 29-1815 of Chapter 29 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Bloomington City Code.

2. BACKGROUND AND SUPPLIMENTAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department Staff receive requests from time to time for various modifications to existing traffic regulations. In accordance with Chapter 29, Section 8, Staff contacts the petitioner, evaluates the request, contacts other potentially effected residents as needed, reviews applicable information/code/regulations, and if advantageous to the general public, incorporates a change on an Emergency and/or Experimental Basis. The modifications are reviewed by Staff several months after implementation, and either removed, modified, or when successful results are achieved, requested to be implemented into City Code. Traffic regulation modifications installed on an Emergency and/or

Experimental basis are only enforceable for 180 days unless City Code is modified with their inclusion. (See §29-204 [Chapter 29: Section 8].)

In addition to modifications completed through the process discussed above, some of the proposed code revisions reflect routine changes such as the installation or removal of a new traffic signal or stop sign, updating street names, correcting typos, or other such general cleanup and updates.

The following modifications are proposed by the attached Draft Ordinance:

1. § 29-703 [Chapter 29: Section 41]: Alleys

The modification to § 29-703 corrects a typo. McLean was indicated when the correct boundary street is McClun.

2. § 29-1611 [Chapter 29: Section 133]: Weight limitations on certain streets.

The modification to § 29-1611 adjusts the weight restriction location limits on Lutz Road following the recent reconstruction project that upgraded the pavement between the Luther Oaks entrance and Morris Avenue.

3. § 29-1801 [Chapter 29: Section 141]: Right, Left and U-Turns Prohibited

A. Left turn prohibited:

The first modification to § 29-1801A updates the intersection name following the Post Office move.

The second modification to § 29-1801A removes a section because Springfield Road no longer exists at this intersection.

The third modification to § 29-1801A updates the time of the prohibition to match current school hours.

B. Left turn permitted on arrow only:

The first modification to § 29-1801B updates the name of K-Mart/Eastland Crossover to reflect the current street name of Empire Crossing.

The second and third modifications to § 29-1801B update the directions prohibited at Veterans at Morris and at Veterans and Eastland to match current IDOT restrictions.

The fourth modification to § 29-1801B corrects the intersection listed to "Veterans at Greenwood" (Morris already listed previously) and updates the directions prohibited to match current IDOT restrictions.

C. U-turn prohibited:

The first modification to § 29-1801C adds the location of Fairway at the north end of the median north of Empire following construction of the median in 2019.

The second modification to § 29-1801C removes the intersection of General Electric at Auto Row/Keaton following the installation of a new traffic signal at this intersection.

The third modification to § 29-1801C updates the locations of U-turn prohibitions on Main Street to match current IDOT restrictions.

The fourth modification to § 29-1801C updates the intersection name used to identify the median following the Post Office relocation.

D. Right turn prohibited

The first modification to § 29-1801D adds a new heading for Stevenson School horseshoe drive exit at Arrowhead to reflect a new specific time restriction.

The second modification to § 29-1801D updates the time to match current school hours. This section is also moved to a new Section "E. Through movement prohibited" since this table does not indicate a right turn prohibition.

The third modification to § 29-1801D removes Empire westbound onto Fairway under the Turn on Red Prohibited section following IDOT's removal of the restriction.

The fourth modification to § 29-1801D updates Eastland/K-Mart Crossover to reflect the current name of Empire Crossing.

4. § 29-1807 [Chapter 29: Section 147] Schedule VII: Restricted Zones for Passenger and Freight Loading from Which Parked Vehicles May Be Towed Under Article XXII of This Chapter.

A. Passenger loading zones.

The first modification to § 29-1807A removes a loading zone at Market and Mason that is no longer required.

The second modification to § 29-1807A removes a loading zone on Roosevelt north of Locust. The loading zone is no longer needed now that Corpus Christi School is no longer at this location.

B. Freight loading zones

The first and second modifications to § 29-1807B convert the freight loading zone on the south side of Jefferson between Main and East into time limited parking.

The third modification to § 29-1807B adds a freight loading zone on Mission Dr. at the request of Home Sweet Home Ministries to aid in handling of donations.

C. Passenger and freight loading zones

The modification to § 29-1807C establishes a passenger and freight loading zone on Stillwell Street as requested by the Director of Heartland Head Start to make it safer for the students during pick up and drop off.

5. § 29-1811 [Chapter 29: Section 151] Schedule XI: Standing or Parking During Certain Hours on Certain Streets Prohibited.

The first modification to § 29-1811 corrects the name of Nord Lane.

The last three modifications to § 29-1811 update the road previously named Emerson to its current name of Bloomington Heights Road.

6. § 29-1815 [Chapter 29: Section 154]: Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets

The first modification to § 29-1815 adds 10-minute parking spots on the east side of Washington St. as requested by the local business.

The second modification to § 29-1815 removes a 2-hour parking restriction on Seminary Street following a change in the adjacent property use. The property owner requested removing the restriction so their tenants could park there.

The third and sixth modifications to § 29-1815 reduce the parking time limit in front of the Government Center on Washington St. to create quicker turnover for residents visiting the City's Hub one-stop service facility.

The fourth and fifth modifications to § 29-1815 convert the freight loading zones on Jefferson between Main and East into time limited parking spots following the change in use of the State Farm Building.

3. STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Transportation Commission pass the following motion:

 Recommend That City Council Approve the Proposed Ordinance modifying Sections 29-703, 29-1611, 29-1801, 29-1807, 29-1811, and 29-1815 of Chapter 29 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) of the Bloomington City Code.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BLOOMINGTON CITY CODE CHAPTER 29 TO INCORPORATE VARIOUS ROUTINE CHANGES TO THE IN-PLACE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AND/OR REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. Bloomington City Code Article VII § 29-703 [Chapter 29: Section 41] shall be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows (additions are indicated by underlining; deletions are indicated by strikeouts):

A. East-west alley bounded by Grove, Denver, Olive and McLean McClun; two-way at east end, one-way eastbound at west end.

SECTION 2. Bloomington City Code Article XVI § 29-1611 [Chapter 29: Section 133] shall be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows (additions are indicated by underlining; deletions are indicated by strikeouts):

SECTION 12. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority granted to the City as a home rule unit by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution.

SECTION 13. This ordinance shall be effective immediately after its approval and publication as required by law.

Chapter 29. Motor Vehicles and Traffic

ARTICLE II. Traffic Administration

§ 29-204. [Ch. 29, Sec. 8] Emergency and experimental regulations.

- A. The City Traffic Engineer or Chief of Police is hereby empowered to make regulations necessary to make effective the provisions of the traffic ordinances of this City and to make and enforce temporary or experimental regulations to cover emergencies or special conditions. No such temporary or experimental regulations shall remain in effect for more than 180 days. [Ord. No. 1984-122]
- B. The City Traffic Engineer may test traffic control devices under actual conditions of traffic.



2. BACKGROUND AND SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

The following comments were received by the Engineering Department between April 16, 2021, and September 13, 2022, or are updates of previous comments (additions to previous updates are **Bold-Underlined**):

- Received Request to replace faded parking restriction signs along Washington Street. <u>Visited site and submitted work order to sign crew. Verified Work Order</u> <u>Completed. Item Considered Closed.</u>
- 2) Received complaint of speeding on E. Oakland east of Hershey, especially around Watford. Due to hill east of Watford, can be worrisome turning from Watford onto Oakland and being overtaken. Request reduction from 40 mph to 30 mph. Completed field check. There is a hill to the east of Watford limiting the view of the intersection from westbound Oakland. There is also an existing "intersection warning" sign with a 30-mph plaque. Could consider speed reduction but would need speed study. 85th percentile likely closer to 40 mph than 30 mph. Speed data collected indicates speeding issues. Road not eligible for traffic calming. Data shared with Police for additional enforcement. Item Considered Closed.
- 3) Received complaint of speeding and request for "Children at Play" signs on Gill Street at pass-through-cul-de-sac west of Airport. Need to evaluate "Yield" sign usage for clarity. Installed traffic cameras to determine number of trucks utilizing the cul-de-sac to avoid traveling through the neighborhood to the west and south on

Vladimir to observe if there are any usual traffic movements. <u>Video reviewed and no</u> <u>trucks on residential streets seen. Work order sent to replace missing signage.</u> <u>Verified work complete. Item Considered Closed.</u>

- Received request for traffic calming on Eastport Drive between Clearwater and Empire. Speed data collected. Speed data was inconclusive, need to collect data in additional locations. <u>Additional speed data collected and met traffic calming</u> <u>criteria. Will design treatment and take to residents for vote.</u>
- 5) Received concern about an increase in collisions on GE Road between Golden Eagle and Towanda Barnes Road. Speed and crash data reviewed: traffic volume too high for traffic calming; no trends in crash data indicating a condition to address. Speed limit valid for type of road. Information provided to Police Department for speeding violations. Item Considered Closed.
- 6) Received two separate concerns about commercial parking on residential portion of Norma Drive. <u>Visited site several times with no signs of commercial parking.</u> <u>Item Considered Closed.</u>
- 7) Received request for no parking in front of a residence on Colton due to constant blocking of driveway. <u>Site visited and discussed with resident. Resident since</u> <u>moved and complaint withdrawn. Item Considered Closed</u>.
- Received complaint of landscaping creating a sight obstruction at Peirce and Mercer. Need to visit site and review when landscaping is in full bloom. <u>Visited site, there is</u> <u>grass that grows tall by end of season. Information sent to code enforcement for</u> <u>review. - 240) <u>NEW:</u> 8/28/22: Received request for an accessible parking spot at 605 E Mulberry. Sign and pavement markings installed. Item Considered Closed.
- 241) <u>NEW:</u> 8/29/22: Received request for roundabout at Euclid and Washington. Resident contacted and explained why roundabout not viable at this intersection. Item Considered Closed.
- 242) <u>NEW:</u> 8/31/22: Received complaint about speed of traffic through school zone on Empire during school release hours. Complaint sent to Police Department. Item Considered Closed.
- 243) <u>NEW:</u> 9/2/22: Received concern about limited number of pedestrian crossings on Veterans Parkway and speeding along road. Contacted resident about IDOT plan to make Veterans Parkway more pedestrian friendly. Item Considered Closed.
