Traffic Crash

Bloomington, IL - On Saturday, 9/24/2022, at approximately 10:59 p.m., Bloomington police officers were dispatched to the area of Center Street and Mulberry Street for a traffic crash. Upon arrival, officers learned a pedestrian had been struck by a vehicle.

The pedestrian was transported from the scene to a local hospital with serious injuries. At the time of this release, the pedestrian has been pronounced deceased by Carle BroMenn Medical Staff.

The circumstances behind this incident are still pending investigation by the Bloomington Police Department and the McLean County Coroner's office.
