BURGLARY SUSPECTS ARRESTED/INDICTED

Bloomington, IL - Following a lengthy investigation by the Bloomington Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division, Peoria Police Department and Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, Dajuan Edwards-Melton was arrested and later indicted. Edwards-Melton was sentenced to 37 months in federal prison for his role in a burglary of a federal licensed firearm dealer in the 2000 Block of Ireland Grove Road. At the time of his arrest, Edwards-Melton was in possession of one of the stolen firearms. Three of the stolen firearms had been used in other crimes in Peoria, a shooting of a 13-year-old male in December 2021, one found during the investigation of an armed vehicular carjacking, and the third was recovered during the foot pursuit of a subject wanted for domestic battery.

Edwards-Melton was indicted by a federal grand jury and entered a guilty plea.

Also charged in this burglary was a 14-year-old male from the St. Louis Area. The juvenile male was charged with possession of stolen firearms (class-X felony) and burglary.

Another 17-year-old male was from Peoria was also arrested and charged with possession of stolen firearms (class-X felony) and burglary.

A juvenile female was also charged during this incident.

Chief Simington stated, "I want to thank the BPD dispatchers, officers, detectives, members of the Peoria Police Department, and Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives, who worked tirelessly on this case. Their collaborative efforts were imperative in keeping our community safe. Through diligent and persistent work, those responsible for this alleged crime which resulted in other violent crimes, will be brought to justice. The BPD will focus our

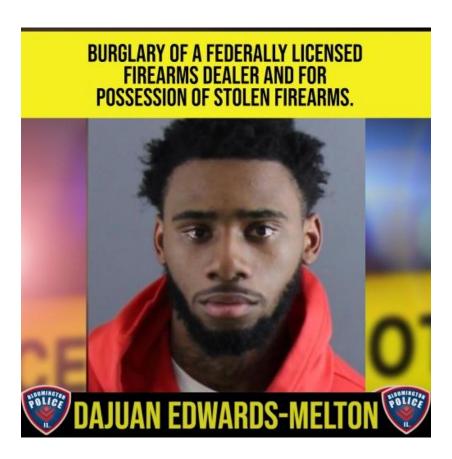
