Bloomington, IL - As millions of travelers hit the road for summer vacations, the Bloomington Police Department is partnering with the Illinois Department of Transportation and the Illinois State Police, to urge motorists to stop speeding and help ensure everyone reaches their destinations safely.

“Over the past few years, we have seen an increase in careless and risky driving. This has been the number one complaint from our numerous public engagement events. No matter how safe of a driver you think you may be, speeding is dangerous,” said Chief Jamal Simington. “Speed limits aren’t a suggestion – they are the law.”

Drivers can expect a ticket from the Bloomington Police Department if they are spotted speeding. Stepped-up patrols will be seen throughout Bloomington and the state July 6-31.

The speed enforcement effort is made possible by federal traffic safety funds administered by IDOT.
