Stolen Vehicle Arrest

Bloomington, IL - The Bloomington Police Department had recently released several advisories in regards to a security issue with Hyundai and Kia vehicles. The BPD Street Crimes Unit (SCU) was tasked with developing a strategy to combat the recent car thefts and associated crimes plaguing the area. Their investigation led to revealing three stolen vehicles, from the Peoria and Bloomington-Normal areas, traveling back and forth between the cities.

On Tuesday, 8/22/2023, at approximately 5:40 p.m., a SCU officer observed an occupied stolen Hyundai sedan. The stolen vehicle stopped in the 1500 block of East College Avenue, in Normal. The driver was seen exiting the vehicle. The suspect saw officers and attempted to flee the area on foot. A BPD officer apprehended the suspect without incident.

An additional stolen Hyundai sedan was recovered in Normal earlier in the day. A third stolen Hyundai sedan was recovered in Bloomington, approximately thirty minutes prior to the previously mentioned arrest. Thank you to the Peoria Police Department and Normal Police Department for your assistance with this investigation.

Chief Jamal Simington stated: "The successful investigative efforts shown in this case reveal the importance of having a unit tasked with focusing on crime trends. We are hopeful this will deter these crimes which have caused significant inconveniences and financial losses to our community members."
