Candidate Physical Agility Test (CPAT)

CPAT is the term used to describe a pass-fail, physical ability test developed by the International Association of Firefighters and the International Association of Fire Chiefs. As a standardized test, it has become a method of assisting fire departments in recruiting those who are physically capable of performing the tasks associated with firefighting.

The tasks include:

Stair Climb Forcible Entry Equipment Carry

Rescue Drag Hose Drag Search

Ladder Climb/Extension Ceiling Breach and Pull

Make sure to prepare for the test by watching the <u>CPAT Test: Pass the Firefighter CPAT Test the (First Time)</u> and the <u>CPAT Workout Video.</u>
