Shots Fired Arrest

Bloomington, IL - On Saturday, 01/27/24, at approximately 9:34 a.m., Bloomington police officers were dispatched to the 2100 block of Todd Drive. Several callers reported seeing a fight and hearing a gunshot. Patrol officers arrived on scene and located evidence of a shots fired incident occurring.

There were no injuries reported as a result of this incident and no property damage was located. An adult female was arrested during the incident. The firearm used in the incident was located and collected as evidence.
