Drive smart: Reduce your speed for safer travel

Bloomington, IL - The Bloomington Police Department today announced it is partnering with the Illinois Department of Transportation, the Illinois State Police and more than 200 local law enforcement agencies to step up enforcement efforts across the state in an effort to reduce speeding. Throughout the month of July, motorists can expect increased patrols looking for speeding, as well as other traffic violations.

Chief Jamal Simington stated, "Excessive speed is the highest causation of injury and fatal crashes. Driving at the speed limit allows for safer travelways and reduces crashes, which results in a safer community."

During the speeding enforcement blitz, officers will intensify enforcement of posted speed limits.

The speed enforcement effort is made possible by federal traffic safety funds administered by IDOT.
