The City’s Boards and Commissions hold Public Hearings prior to some Council items appearing on the Council’s Meeting Agenda. Persons who wish to address the Council should provide new information which is pertinent to the issue before them.

The Council may vote to suspend the rules to allow citizen input on Regular Agenda items. If this occurs, public input will be limited to three (3) persons in support of and three (3) persons in opposition to said item. Input will be limited to five (5) minutes per person. Said person must provide their name and address for the record.)
