(Recommend that the petition requesting approval of the Final Plat for the Bloomington Seed Plant Subdivision with the following waivers: 1.) waiver of the Preliminary Plan requirement; 2.) waiver of the requirement that the final plat include all contiguous property in common ownership or unified control; 3.) waiver of the requirement that sanitary sewer and water be extended to the site; 4.) waiver of the requirement for storm water detention; and 5.) waiver of the requirement that a bond be provided to bring the north half of Hendrix Road up to City standards and the Ordinance be passed.)**
