Re: Liquor Commission Hearing of December 14, 2010, located in the Conference Room, 109 E. Olive St.

4:00 p.m. Application of OSF St. Joseph Medical Center Foundation located at 2200 E. Washington St., for an LB liquor license, which will allow the selling and serving of beer and wine by the glass for consumption on the premise from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. on February 18, 2011.

Request of Jerome and Tammie Bossingham to allow moderate consumption of alcohol at their May 27, 2011 wedding reception to be held at Davis Lodge at Lake Bloomington. CJ's Restaurant will cater the event for approximately 150 people from 5:30 to 12:00 p.m. (Midnight).

Application of Heartland Apple Bloomington, LLC, d/b/a Applebee's Neighborhood Grill & Bar, located at 502 N. Veterans Parkway, requesting an RAS liquor license which allows consumption of all types of alcohol on the premises seven (7) days a week. Currently this license holder is operating under T.S.S.O. North, Inc., and has created a new corporation effective January 1, 2011. *The corporate officers for this corporation remain the same.*

Application of Orient Cuisine, Inc., d/b/a Orient Gourmet, located at 2103 N. Veterans Pkwy. #312, requesting an RBS liquor license which would allow the sale of beer and wine only by the glass for consumption on the premises seven (7) days a week.

Text Amendment for Chapter 6, Section 1, Tastings.

Violation hearing of OHM Liquor, Inc., d/b/a Famous Wine & Spirits, located at 1404 E. Empire currently holding a PAS liquor license which allows the sale of all types packaged alcohol for consumption off the premises seven (7) days a week.
