The application of Famous Trading, Inc., d/b/a Famous Wine & Spirits located at 1404 E. Empire requesting a PAS liquor license which would allow the sale of all types packaged alcohol for consumption off the premises seven (7) days a week.

Application of Herradura, LLC, d/b/a Herradura, located at 909 N. Hershey Rd., requesting an RAS liquor license which would allow the sale of all types of alcohol by the glass for consumption on the premises seven (7) days a week.

The request from Highland Park CVS, LLC, d/b/a CVS/Pharmacy #8660, located at 210 N. Center St., currently holding a PA liquor license which allows the sale of all types of packaged alcohol for consumption off the premise (6) six days a week to change classification to a PAS which would allow the sale of all types of packaged alcohol for consumption off the premise (7) seven days a week.

The application of Downtown Bloomington Association for a limited liquor license which allows the sale of all types of alcohol for the event called "Hot August Nights," to be held on August 15, 2009.

Discussion of proposed text amendment to Chapter 6, Alcoholic Beverages, to extend Sunday sales from 12 noon to an earlier time.
