For any day with precipitation, estimates of storm duration are derived from rain intensity trends, which are interfaced to the District SCADA system. Total daily rainfall is reported as defined by the District's twenty-four hour composite sampling schedule. For the BNWRD, start time is 7am and ends the following day at 7am.
