Case BHP-9-13. Review of the application submitted by Green Building LLC, (Bob Vericella/Fred Wollrab) requesting an up to \$25,000.00 Harriet Fuller Rust Facade Grant consisting of tuck pointing, masonry repairs, steel lintel repairs, metal repairs, new vent covers, and replace window sills for the B.S. Green building, Arthur L. Pillsbury Architect, 1901, located at 115 E. Monroe Street, in the Downtown Bloomington National Register Historic District.

Mr. Vericella and E.J. Garneau indicated the location of four sample sills placed on the building.

The sub-committee members reviewed the limestone samples that were placed on the building ledge. There were four different colors presented to the committee. The consensus was that the far right sill was closest in color to the existing brick on the building.

After due discussion, Mr. Kennedy made a motion to approve the far right, #1 labeled stone for the sill replacement. Mr. Brad Williams seconded the motion which passed by a vote of 3-0.
