

WINTER SAFETY TIPS

ice and snow take it slow







keep reading for driving safety tips as well as tips for a safe home!



s a f e t y

keep the gas tank full

inspect your vehicle's antifreeze, battery, brakes & brake fluid, defroster, heater, lights, motor oil, seatbelts, tire pressure, windshield wiper fluid, & wiper blades

check the weather forecast

store items that you will need in an emergency:



food, water, gloves, boots, flashlight, batteries, blanket, medication, road flares, first-aid kit

push down hard on the brakes. If you do not have anti-lock brakes gently pump the pedal. watch for black-ice which forms on bridges, off-ramps, and shady areas before it does slow down on curvesslow down ahead of time for intersections

> PERISHIBLE FOOD CAN BE STORED OUTSIDE IN THE SNOW OR IN AN UNHEATED GARAGE




