Call the BCPA Ticket Office at (309)434-2777 or toll free at (866)686-9541 to reserve your seats. Classes should have one chaperone for every 15 students. Everyone must be included in your total if they want to watch the performance.

All sales are final. We are not able to give refunds or exchanges. Only if a school officially closes on the day of a planned performance will the BCPA allow an exchange for another performance within 12 months.

You must confirm the total number attending by April 2, 2015 and payment received by April 9, 2015.

Please make payment by check, credit card (MasterCard, VISA, & Discover accepted), or by cash in larger bills (preferably no ones or coins) and mailed to BCPA Ticket Office, 600 N East St, Bloomington, IL 61701. There is a \$5 administrative fee for each order and a 4% City Amusement Fee Tax for each order. When placing your order, please inform the Ticket Office if anyone in your group is in need of accessibility services.

All sales are final. We are not able to give refunds or exchanges. Only if a school officially closes on the day of a planned performance will the Auditorium allow an exchange for another performance within the same season.

You must confirm the total number attending 3 weeks prior to the performance. Payment must be received 2 weeks prior to the performance. Payment may be made by credit card, money order, cash, or check payable to Sangamon Auditorium Tickets and mailed to: Sangamon Auditorium Ticket Office, University of Illinois Springfield, One University Plaza, MS PAC 292, Springfield, IL 62703. Each order placed over the phone will be assessed a \$4 processing fee. Patrons who come to the Ticket Office in person and place a complete order (including payment) on the same day will not be assessed the \$4 fee. When placing your order, please inform the Ticket Office if anyone in your group is in need of accessibility services.
